## Join Here for the Girls at Its 13th Annual Pink Carpet Gala!

**Williamsburg, VA, September 1, 2019** – Here for the Girls welcomes the public to attend its annual Pink Carpet Gala on September 21, 2019, where A Calendar to Live By 2020 will be unveiled. This year the organization welcomes special guest emcee WTKR/News 3 anchor Jessica Larche.

The annual Pink Carpet Gala is a special event to celebrate the unveiling of the organization's A Calendar to Live By and to introduce its new calendar models to the community, as well as an opportunity to celebrate and raise funds for the organization's mission to improve the lives of young women affected by breast cancer. The gala attracts approximately 600 attendees each year from across the region. The Here for the Girls annual calendar features breast cancer survivors and their stories; tucked inside the calendar is A Guide to Caring for Yourself, which offers important health information on breast cancer, managing risk, early detection, healthy lifestyle choices, and other related topics.

"Our calendar is special because it is so much more than a calendar. It is a guide for healthy living, for breast cancer survivors and for the general public as well," says Here for the Girls Executive Director Chris Schwab. "And for young women newly diagnosed with breast cancer, the calendar's stories about other young women experiencing the same thing lets them know that they are not alone in this."

This will mark the 13th edition of the award-winning calendar. "The original goal was and still is education – to debunk the myth that it's just an older woman's disease. We want women to be informed health advocates for themselves," Schwab says.

The Pink Carpet Gala is a fun evening that helps connect guests to the mission of Here for the Girls. "This is a night of fun, dancing, great food, and great wine, all while making a difference for young women with breast cancer. The night is sure to be memorable for all who attend," says Here for the Girls Development and Events Manager Amanda Capozzi.

"I'm amazed at how much the community has become involved with this event and the women we serve. Through the funds we raise at our Pink Carpet Gala, we help make a difference in the lives of these young women by giving them support and helping them find their new fabulous!"

Since 2007, the nonprofit has welcomed its new calendar with this signature fundraising event, which has become more popular with each passing year. Here for the Girls received three gold National Calendar Awards (Most Informative, Best Non-Profit, and Best Graphic Design) from the Calendar Marketing Association (CMA) for its A Calendar to Live By 2019. The organization has submitted its annual calendar to the CMA for 11 years and has won at least one award each year.

The Pink Carpet Gala will take place at 6 p.m. September 21 at the DoubleTree by Hilton, 50 Kingsmill Road, Williamsburg. The models from the new calendar will be the evening's special guests, and Here for the Girls welcomes the public to come enjoy a delicious 3-course dinner, beer and wine, dancing, an extensive raffle and other fundraising opportunities, a complimentary 2020 calendar, and more!
