



H4TG: Volunteer Position Description

IN-PERSON FACILITATOR

Purpose: The position of In-Person Facilitator serves as the peer-lead volunteer for Here for the Girls, supporting the organization's mission of improving the lives of young women affected by breast cancer. The In-Person Facilitator manages and runs our in-person support group.

Key Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate an understanding of our mission, values, and culture.
- Be an active Boober! (attended a minimum of six in-person support group gatherings).
- Be educated about breast cancer basics and the various ways it affects a person as a whole.
- Be committed to continuous learning – new breast cancer advances, interpersonal skills, and healthy living.
- Be trustworthy and transparent, with acceptable background check.
- Be respectful of all people, regardless of race, religion, sexual orientation, etc.
- Have a can-do attitude, ability to adapt, and be a team player.
- Be an effective communicator/active listener and able to guide open dialogue.
- Effectively represent H4TG to the medical and local community.
- Demonstrate awareness of the needs of young breast cancer survivors.
- Have a flexible schedule to be able to keep in touch with H4TG and attend additional trainings and monthly calls.

Time Commitment: A facilitator is asked to commit to their role for a two-year period with assessment at the end of one year. After two years, if interested, the facilitator may be renewed at the discretion of H4TG.

Your commitment will be detailed in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

Qualifications: Basic understanding of how breast cancer impacts young women under 51 and how to effectively lead a group to provide support for those young women.
